Here children are playing in the wooded undergrowth



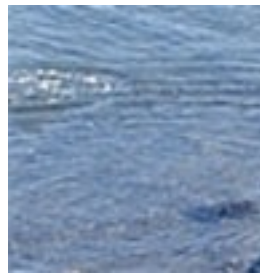
Vv Valley

We have the river, lakes and spring water in our taps here



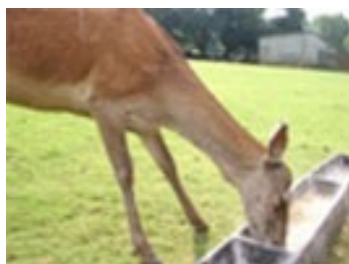
Xx axe

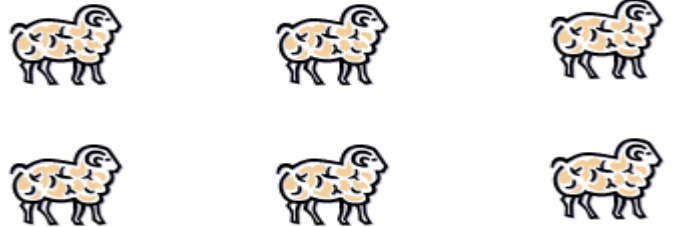

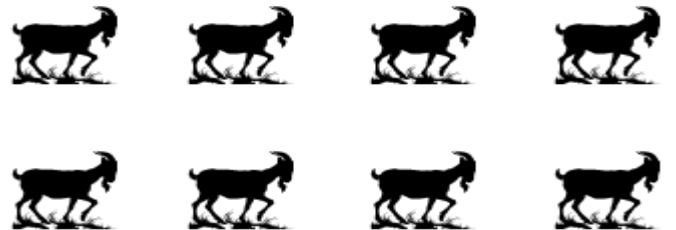

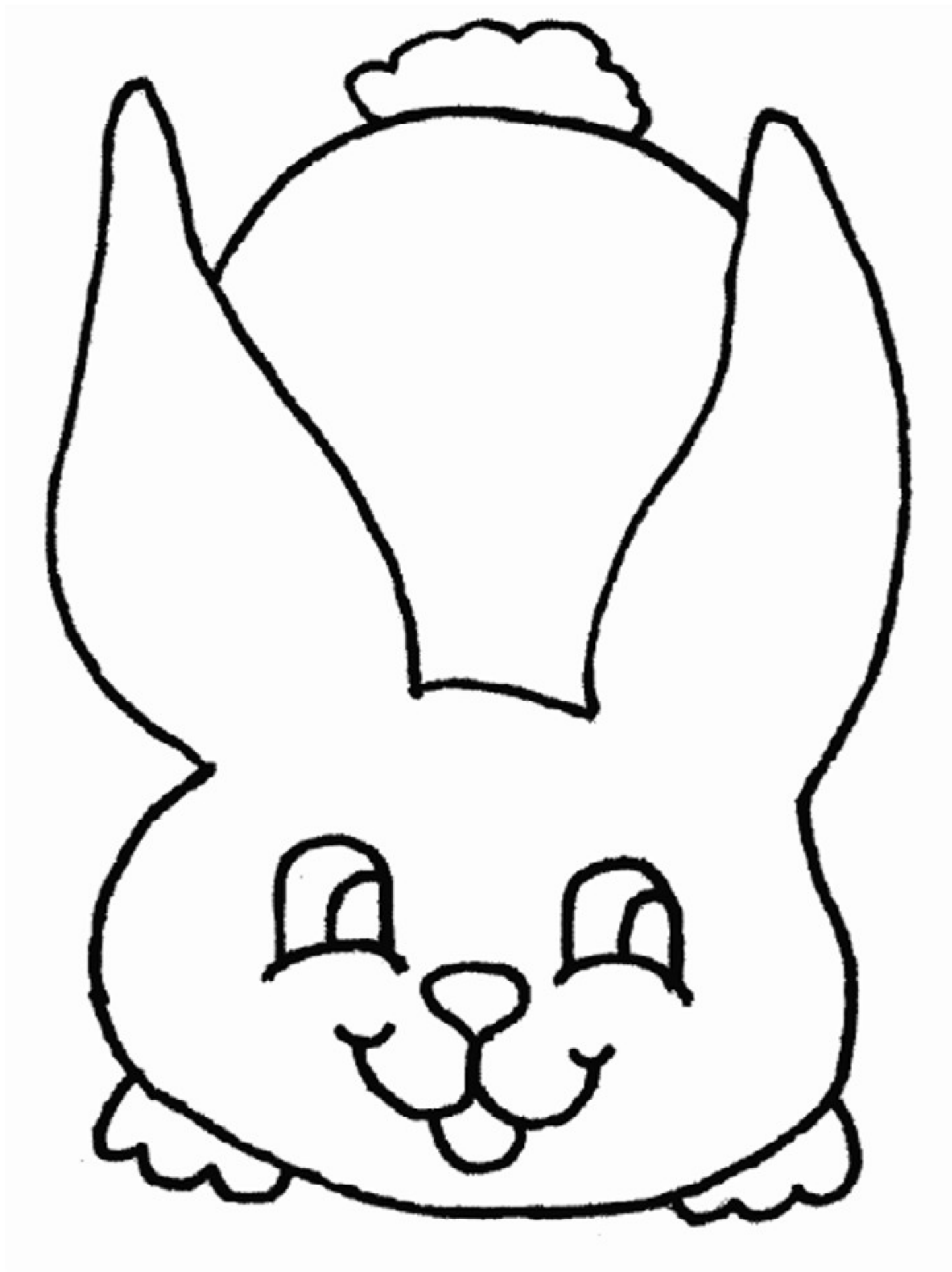
Colour the Deer

This is a male called a he has large antlers.



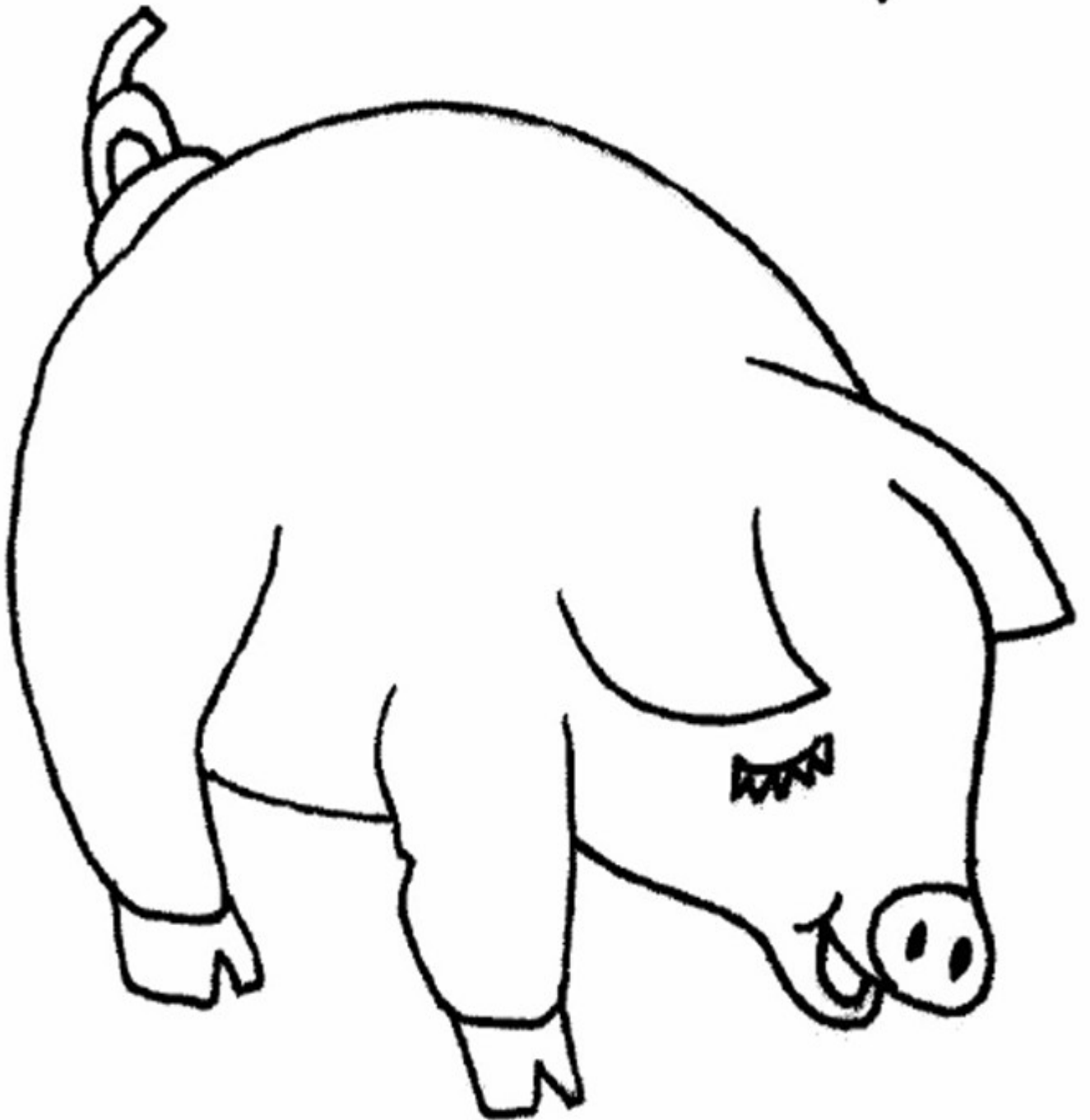
Colour the rabbit
